



DISPLAY DIMENSIONS ~ WELCOME!!

Art Gallery is on second floor of the Library. Please review all instructions at lamorindaarts.org/gallery/exhibitor-information-instructions

Lighting – Entire art gallery, including interior of glass cases, is lit by LED lighting day and night. Labels identifying art – please note in photos.

White Wall – West Facing Wall Adjacent to Library Auditorium Doors (see photos)

- 40 feet wide and 9 feet in height.

Wood Walls – Four South Facing Recessed Walls Near Library Entrance (see photos)

- 4 recessed panels, each 10 feet wide for a total of 40 feet.
- Each recessed panel is further divided into three vertical sections.
- Each section is 3 feet 4 inches wide and 89 inches (7.4 feet) in height.
- Under each section of panels there are benches where people can sit. Be aware, the average person's head is 34 inches above the bench.

3 Shelf Glass Case – West Facing, Near Garden Room (see photos)

- 120 inches or 10 feet wide; total interior height top to bottom is 7 feet.
- Top unmovable shelf height is 50-1/2 inches.
- Second unmovable shelf height is 16 inches.
- Bottom unmovable shelf height is 15-1/2 inches.
- Each of the three shelves is 18 inches deep.

4 Shelf Glass Case – South Facing, Adjacent to Auditorium Doors (see photos)

- 162 inches or 13-1/2 feet wide (takes up one entire wall of art gallery).
 - Total interior height from top to bottom is 74 inches.
 - Top, second and third unmovable shelves are each 18 inches deep.
 - Bottom unmovable shelf is 21-1/2 inches deep.
 - Top shelf height is 28 inches.
 - Second, third and fourth shelves are each 13-1/2 inches in height.

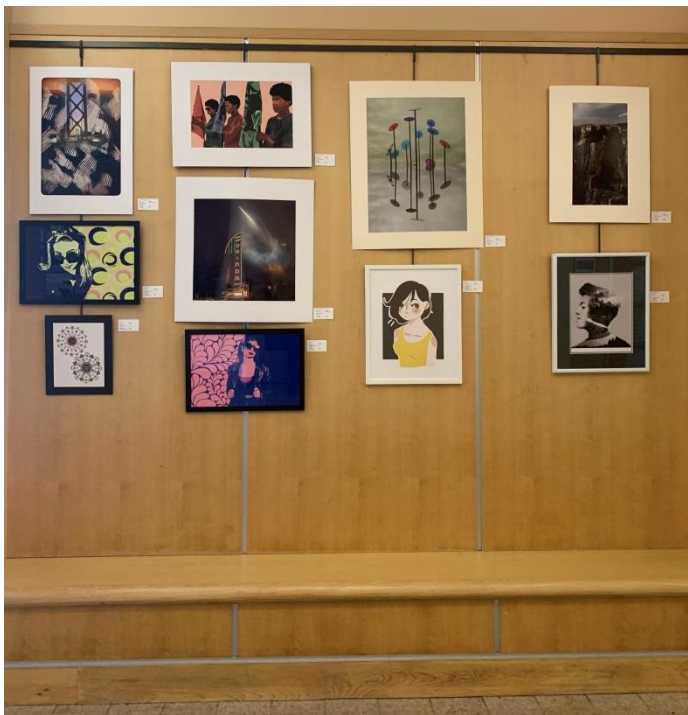

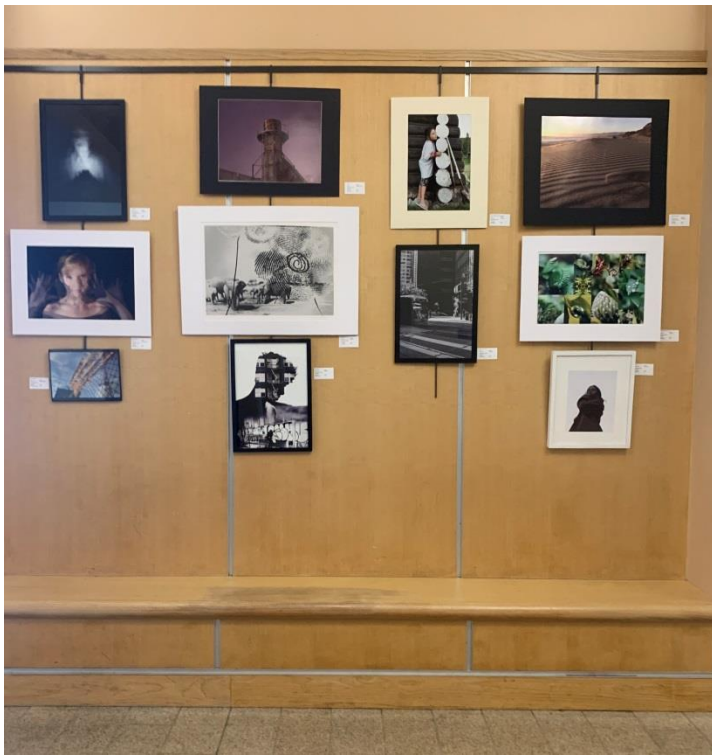

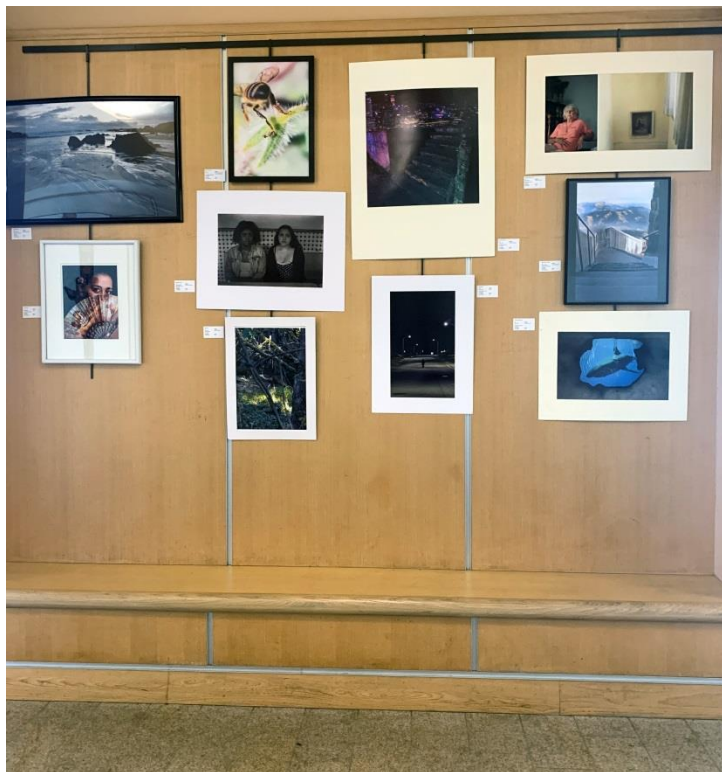

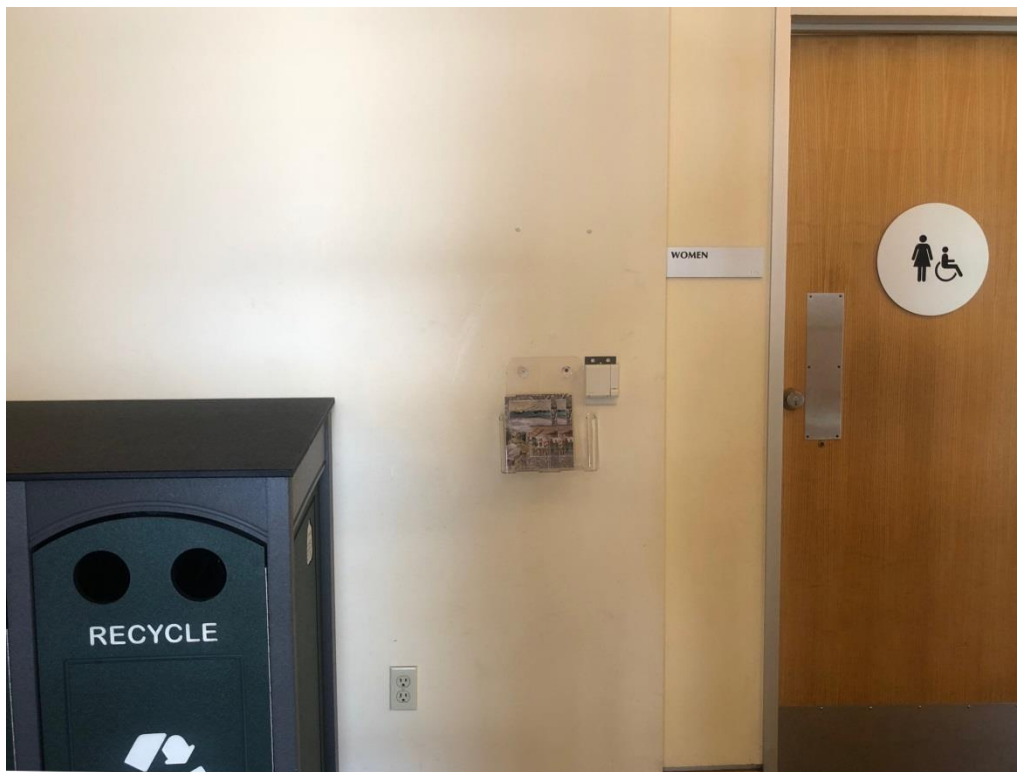

View of Foyer from 3 Shelf Glass Case to Interior Entrance of Orinda Library on Far Left



Rectangular metal hanger pictured at left is ready to receive wire on back of artwork or frame; wire should span entire width of artwork or frame.



Affix wire to artwork or frame with flat-eye hooks strung taught 2” below top of artwork or frame.

Metal hanger is easy to position by pulling it away from the wall and moving it left or right. Affix metal hanger to vertical rod with the set screw which you then thumb tighten.

Fiberglass rod lies flat against wall and is easily moved to desired position. Go here for link to, “How to hang a painting with wire

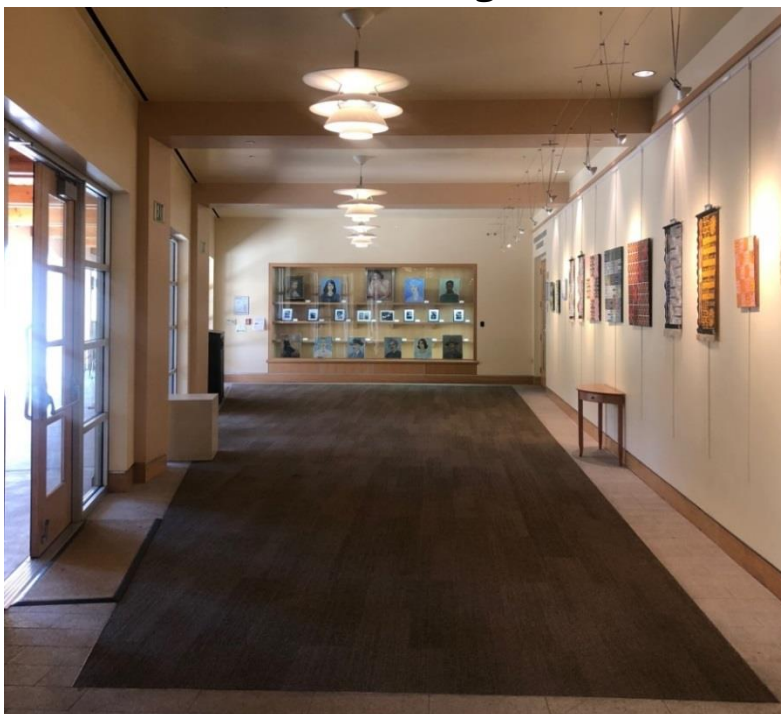

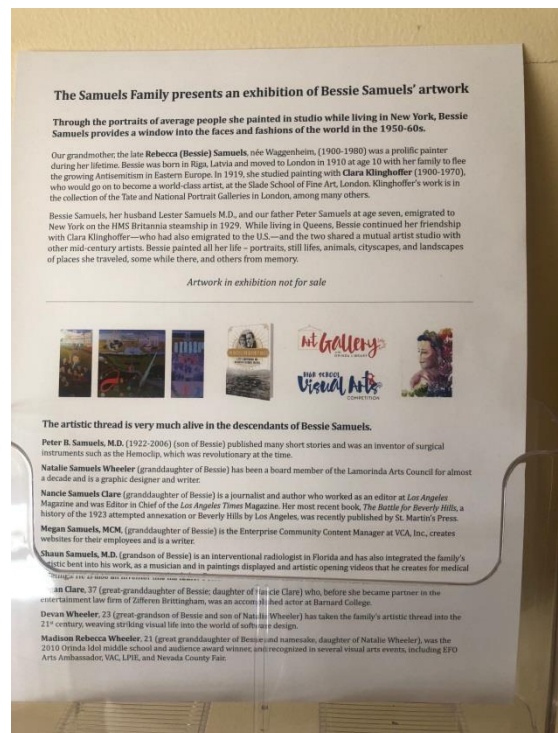

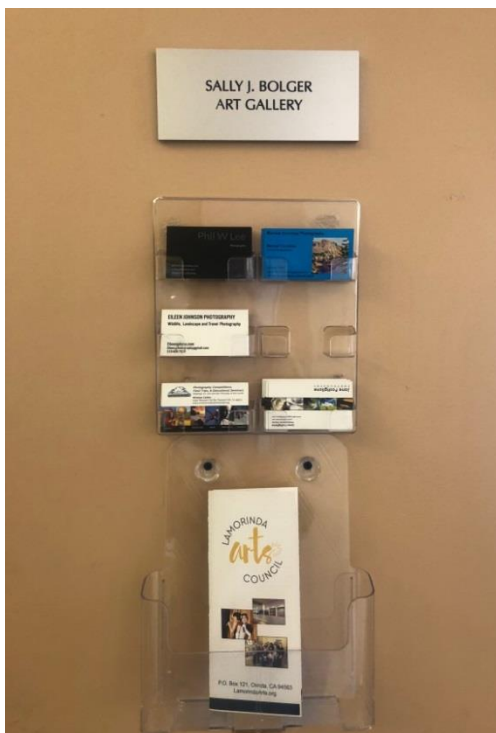


Media Holder to Left of 4 Shelf Glass Case for Exhibitor Use ~ Sample of Exhibitor Use on Right
